



## Formulary Update

### 1. Adderall® XR Capsules

**Notice Date: April 29, 2009**

On April 1, 2009, Teva Pharmaceuticals launched generics to Shire's Adderall® XR (mixed salts of a single-entity amphetamine product) capsules, a drug commonly used for the treatment of attention-deficit hyperactive disorder (ADHD). Generics are now available to the 5mg, 10mg, 15mg, 20mg, 25mg and 30mg capsules. Teva's generic is equivalent to Shire's Adderall XR.

Now that generics are established in the marketplace, Express Scripts will remove the brand Adderall XR from Express Scripts formularies, replacing it with the equivalent generic drug. The brand-name product, Adderall XR, will be converted to non-formulary status on May 15, 2009.

### 2. Topamax® Sprinkle Capsules

**Notice Date: May 13, 2009**

On April 15, 2009 the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved generics to Ortho-McNeil-Janssen Pharmaceuticals Topamax® (topiramate) Sprinkle Capsules, a medication commonly for the treatment of seizures and prevention of migraines. Generics to Topamax Sprinkle Capsules now join generics to Topamax tablets.

Now that generics are established in the marketplace, Express Scripts will remove the brand Topamax Sprinkle Capsules from Express Scripts formularies, replacing them with the equivalent generic drug. The brand-name product, Topamax Sprinkle Capsules, will be converted to non-formulary status on June 1, 2009.
